**EMAT Emergency Management Technology & Innovation Award**

This award is not for contracted products, projects or programs developed by a third party with grant funds obtained specifically for that purpose.

Eligible recipients: Any local or regional-level emergency management program in Texas.

Criteria for Award: This is an annual award which may be given to multiple recipients. This award recognizes and honors local and/or regional-level programs which developed and implemented a technology product/project or innovation in Texas during the previous calendar year (2013) which:

- Was developed at the local or regional level; and
- Was successfully implemented and tested during an exercise, special event, or emergency

circumstance; and

Can be replicated at little or no cost by other local or regional programs;
